



## Job Description

### Counselor-In-Training (CIT)

**Classification:** Seasonal

**Reports to:** Program Director OR CIT Coordinator

**Staff Minimal Qualifications:**

- Active Christian faith
- Ability to perform potentially strenuous physical activities (hiking, camp-outs, etc.)
- Comfortable with building Christian community by leading, teaching and equipping others
- Ability to work well with others
- Must be a lifeguard and/or comfortable assisting in the facilitation of High Ropes
- Must be able to work a **Minimum 3 weeks** of summer camp
- Must participate in at least 1 week of staff training and must participate in an additional weekend training
- Willing to be a positive role model in the live of others
- Willing to take on a challenge and do tasks outside of comfort zone
- Must be 16 years or older

**Responsibilities:**

- Maintain safety and well-being of campers participating in water activities
- Maintain safety and well-being of campers participating in high ropes/tower activities
- Work alongside other staff members to promote safety and well-being of campers
- Create a welcoming environment for other CITs and staff members.
- Secondary Responsibilities may include one or more of the below roles
  - Administration
  - Food Service
  - Maintenance
  - Program

- Experience, Explore, and Enrich Faith Formation across camp
- Plan and debrief activities to reflect the Gospel and develop character
- Instill an appreciation of the outdoors in campers
- Nurture leadership qualities in self, staff, and campers
